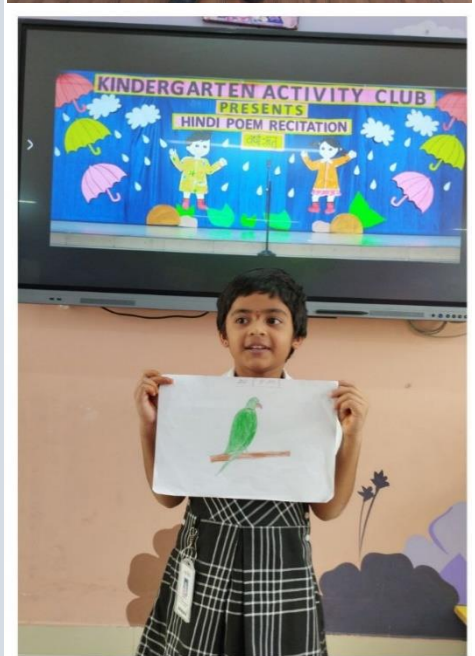

Study Schedule: Pre-schoolers respond well to schedules, set aside a time for reading or writing or for educational game every day. Choose any one activity to maintain continuity.

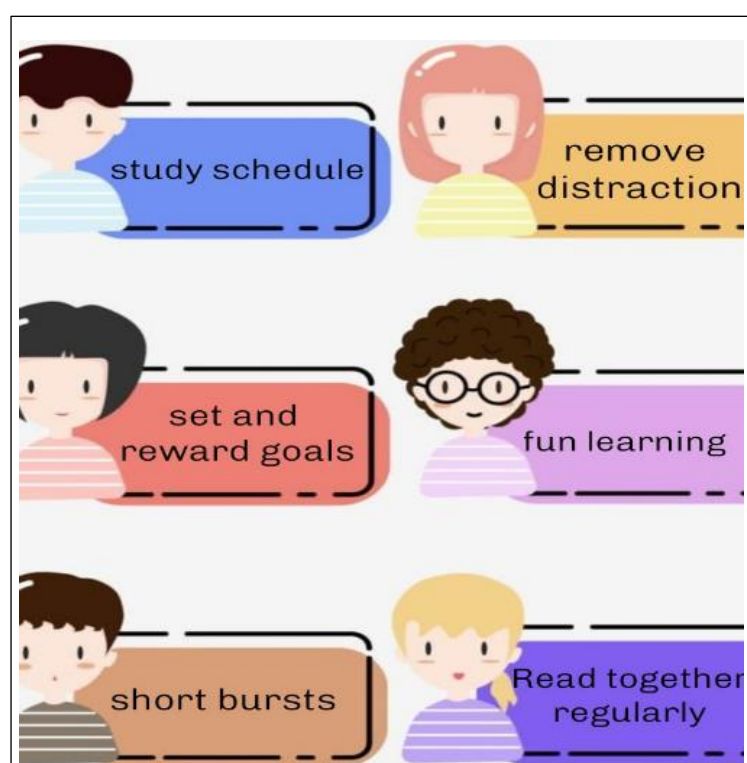

Fun learning: Keep learning fun, revise concepts into everyday activities and they will learn without realising that they are learning.

Read together regularly: Choose interactive books and engage with the story by asking open-ended question.
