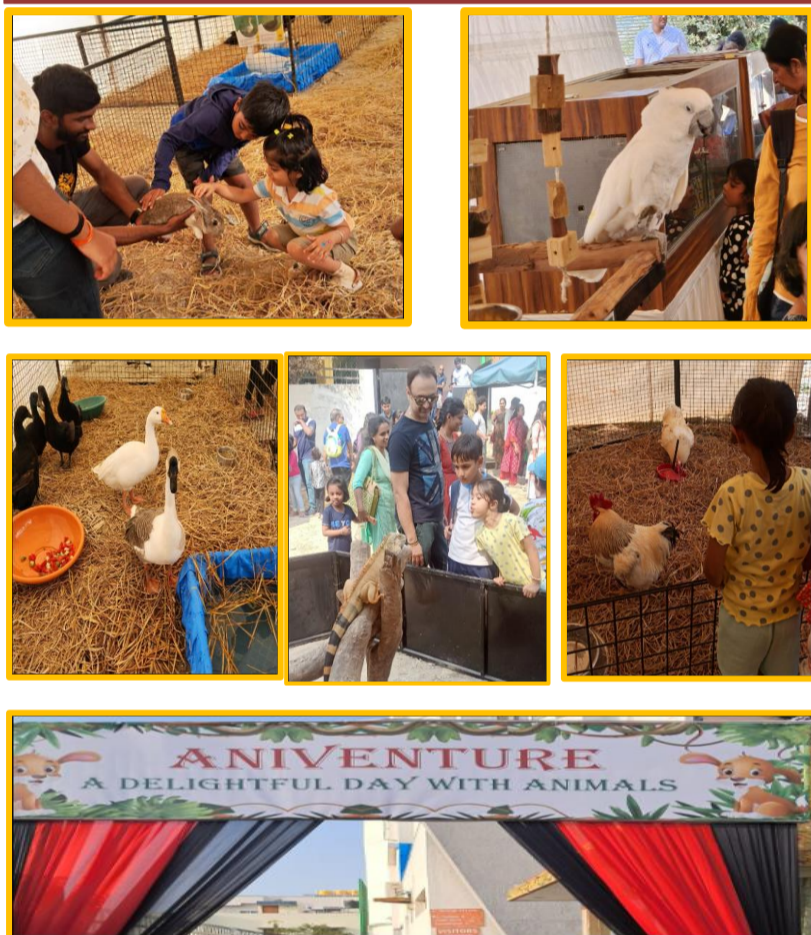


## Shri Ram Mandir Pran Pratishtha Celebration

## Aniventure- A delightful day with animals

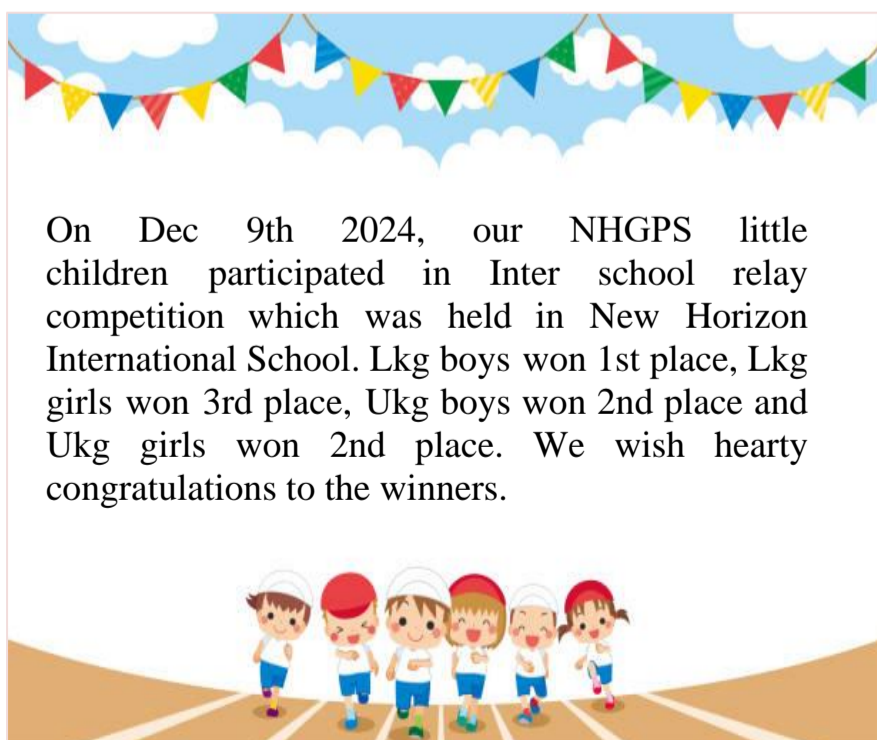
