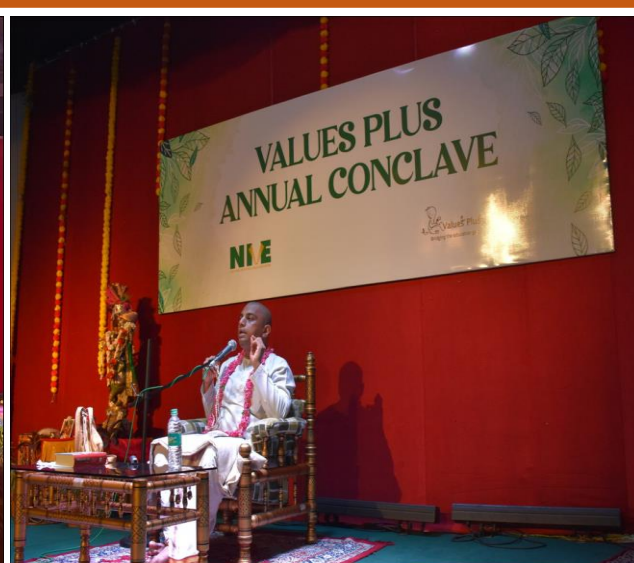
Empowering Educators

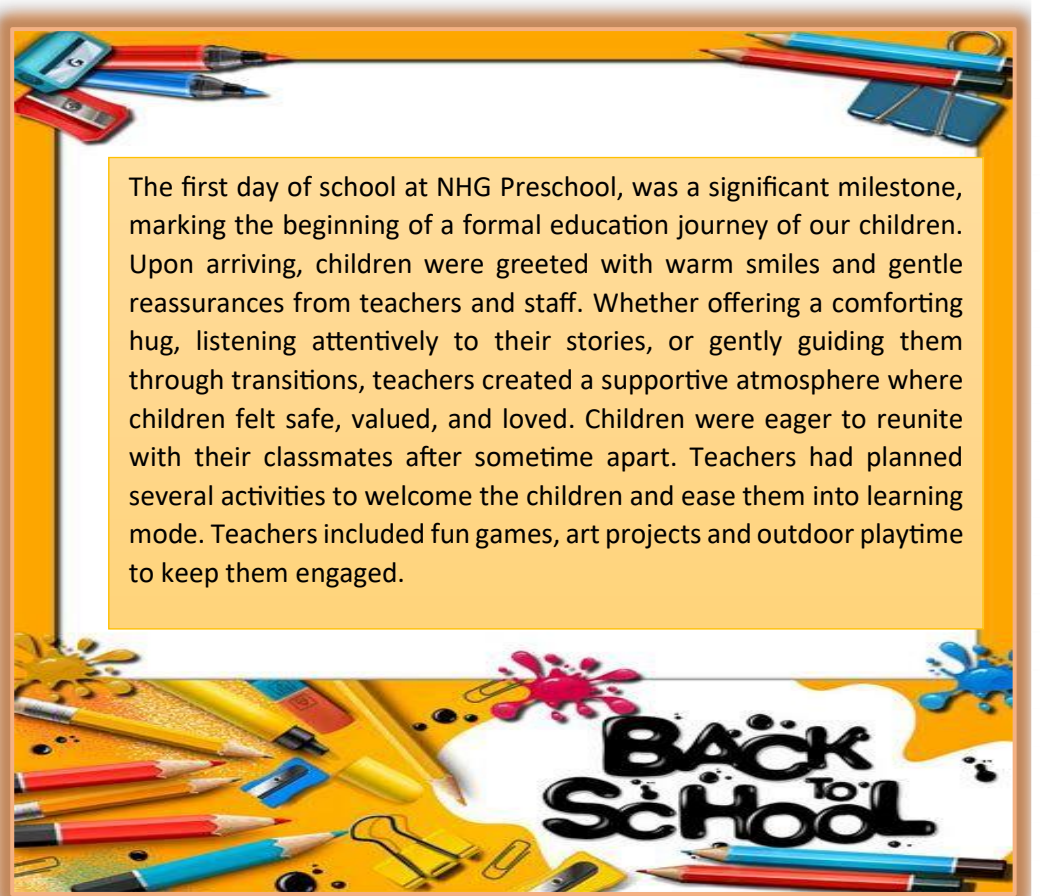
Teachers Conclave at the ISKCON
