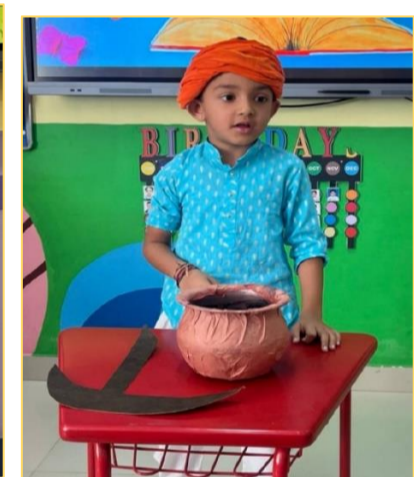
Ganesh Chaturthi Celebration
