








#### Field Trip (LKG & Playgroup)

# PRIDE skills — five ways to provide positive parenting

The PRIDE skills are five positive parenting techniques that can easily be used in everyday life. The skills have been shown in studies to be a successful way to support children's development.



- PRAISE makes children feel good
- **REFLECTION** involves repeating back a child's words and elaborating on what the child said.
- **IMITATION** involves playing in a similar way as your child or making similar gestures.
- **DESCRIPTION** involves describing what your child is doing, much like giving a playby-play narration of a game.
- expressing warmth and positivity with your words and actions while you play and interact with your child.



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
