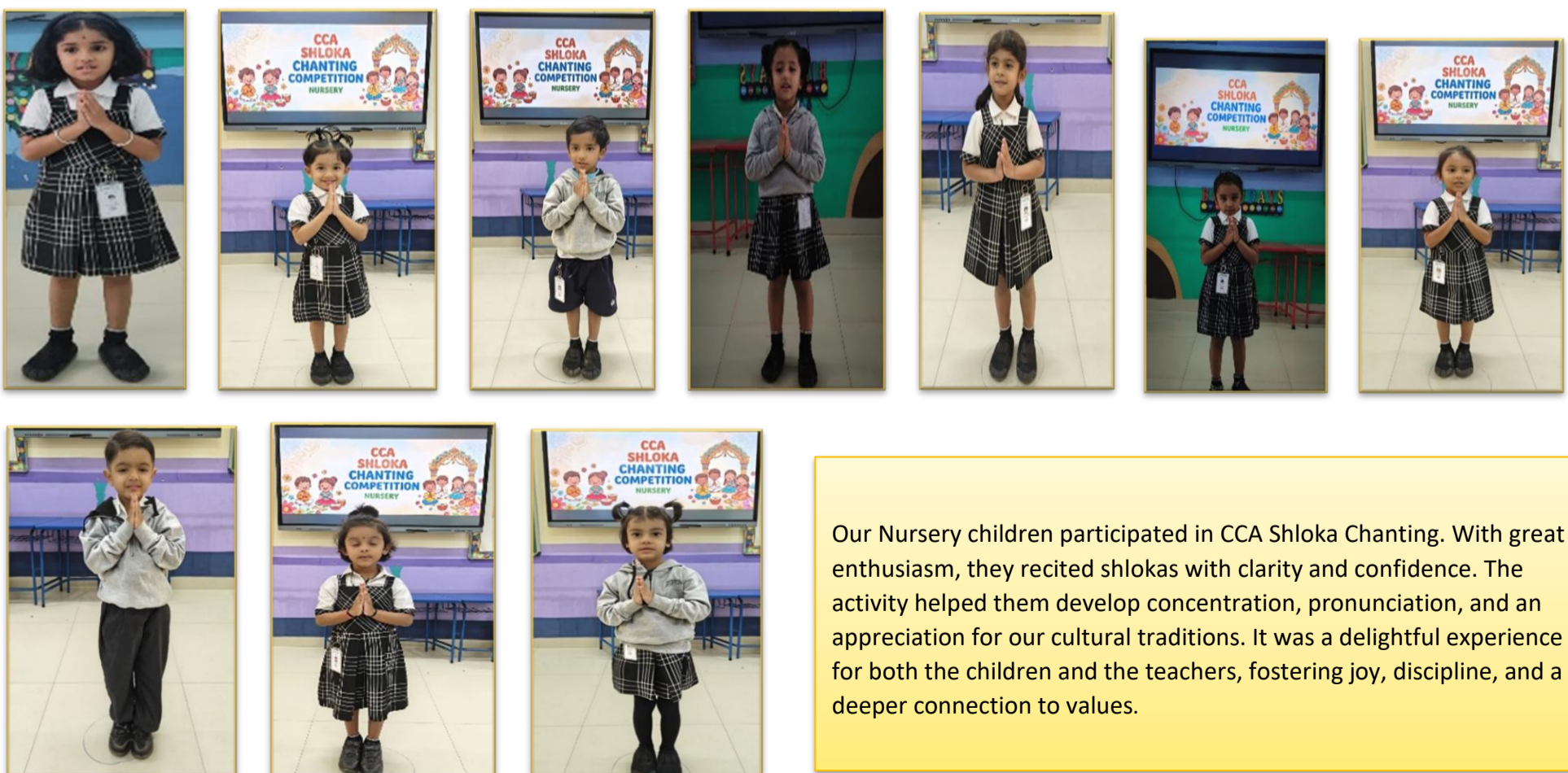

CCA Shloka Chanting

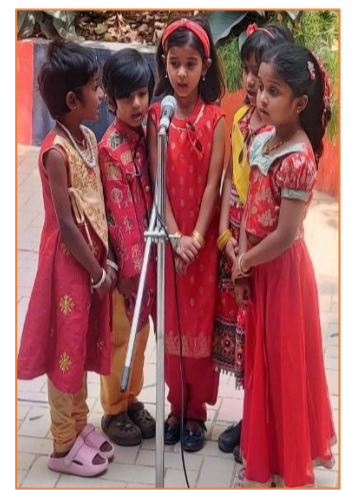
